

## **Ceremony for 8P classes – Friday 1 July 2022 – Victoria Hall**

### **INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES/PARENTS**

#### **From 3.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. – Official ceremony**

From 3.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m., the Victoria Hall will welcome 8P pupils and their teachers for a ceremony dedicated to pupils who are finishing primary school (*leaflet to be downloaded at the bottom of the page*).

It is an important step in a pupil's life: the end of childhood and the beginning of adolescence with all the challenges that implies.

To mark this transition, the City of Geneva is organising an official event for the pupils and their teachers.

As the ceremony is held during school time, it is not open to parents.

#### **From 4.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. - Welcome in the Parc des Bastions**

As soon as the ceremony is over, the pupils will travel to the Parc des Bastions with their classes accompanied by their teachers, municipal police officers, school patrol officers and the school service staff.

Once there, they can then enjoy the entertainment organised for the Schools Fair for classes 5P-8P.

#### **From 5 p.m. - Opening of the festivities in Parc de Bastions**

Parents must meet their child or children on site. To make the meeting points easier to find, signs showing the names of the primary cycle schools will be installed near the tables. From this point, the pupils will no longer be under the responsibility of their teachers.
