Schools on the southern shore

1 p.m. – Arrival at Victoria Hall

The pupils of class 8P at the schools on the southern shore will travel from their school on foot or by public transport and will be accompanied by the teaching staff.

From 1.30 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. – Official ceremony
